WELCOME TO THE 2025 PICK A READING PARTNER PROGRAM!

Pick a Reading Partner (PARP) was developed as a program in 1987 by Senator Donovan, with the goal of linking home and school to develop and foster a love of reading. PARP encourages students to read with a partner (such as a parent, grandparent, babysitter, older sibling, or family member) for at least 20 minutes a day. The daily activity of reading together promotes reading for fun and information, builds reading and communication skills, and strengthens the relationship with his or her reading partner. This year, we are excited to include our Read-A-Thon fundraiser as part of the program!

TRACK YOUR MINUTES AND EARN PRIZES WITH READ-A-THON

Family and friends can support student reading efforts by sponsoring them through Read-A-Thon! Students will use their Read-A-Thon dashboard to log their partner reading minutes, raise money for our school, redeem rewards from the prize shop, and compete for PARP school prizes outlined on p3.

Please register by **Sunday, January 26** in advance of our PARP Kickoff. **When a class has 15** students registered for Read-A-Thon, the entire class will earn a fun giveaway. The first class to have all students registered will win a **\$50** Amazon gift card! Registration takes less than 5 minutes by following these easy steps:

- Visit <u>read-a-thon.com/signup</u> (or scan the QR code)
- Click "Start a Read-A-Thon"
- Select "Register as a Reader" (if prompted, enter the code: 3292516)
- Select your child's teacher from the drop down menu
- Select "I do not see my reader"
- Complete the required fields with name and email
- Follow the prompts to share your site with family and friends

Be sure to check out the Read-A-Thon prize shop! As sponsors pledge their support, students will earn 15% of what they raise to shop for prizes. In the dashboard, you will see a "shop now" button, as well as your available "money to spend" in the store. There are lots of great prizes starting at \$0.15 – top prizes include a Nintendo Switch and an Xbox Series X! All prizes will be delivered to the school.
